Dr. Christina L. Faust, a Girl Scout alum from Cedar Shoals (Athens area, Region 1) was the featured speaker for the annual Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia Promises to Keep fundraising breakfast on September 9. Dr. Faust is a graduate of University of Georgia and Princeton University, and is currently a postdoctoratal scholar in the Center for Infectious Disease Dynamics at Penn State University.

Dr. Faust shared how her experiences as a lifelong Girl Scout impacted her life and incredible career as a researcher. "Things I learned from doing my Gold Award project still apply to my daily life. 
