



Volunteer of Excellence Endorsement

The Volunteer of Excellence recognizes a volunteer who has contributed outstanding service while partnering directly with girls to implement the Girl Scout Leadership Experience or who have contributed out-standing support of the council's mission-delivery to girl and adult members. There are two versions of this award—one focusing on service directly to girls and the other focusing on service to adults. A volunteer may be selected for the award twice (once for service to girls and once for service to adults).

Eligibility for Consideration (will be evaluated at the Council level)

- Only service prior to October 1 of the current school year may be included
- Registered adult in GSHG
- Completed background check
- Owes no money to the council
- 2 endorsements from different people describing the support required
