



## COOKIE DOUGH USAGE

GSHG cookie dough can be used for: shop purchases in store or online, council events, council sponsored trips, GSHG resident camp, Girl Scout Destinations, district and service area sponsored events, Gold or Silver Award project expenses, Girl Scouts of the USA Lifetime membership (Ambassadors who are graduating high school only).

All unused GSHG cookie dough earned during the 2018 cookie program will expire on **December 15, 2018**.

### SHOP PURCHASES

In store cookie dough can be used to make purchases in any of the GSHG council shops. Girls must present a copy of their personalized emailed cookie dough card at the time of purchase. When orders are placed over the phone or via email for in office pick up, a copy of the cookie dough card must be forwarded via email at the time the order is placed.

### ONLINE COOKIE DOUGH

Online cookie dough can only be used at the GSHG online shop. Girls who choose online cookie dough receive a gift certificate number via email directly from Girl Scouts of the USA.

### COUNCIL EVENTS AND SPONSORED TRIPS

Cookie dough can be used to attend council sponsored events and trips. Girls are to present a copy of their personalized emailed cookie dough at the time of registration. The cookie dough should be emailed to [programregistrar@gshg.org](mailto:programregistrar@gshg.org) along with a completed Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia Cookie Dough Redemption form.

### GSHG RESIDENT CAMP

Cookie dough can be used to cover a portion of the resident camp. Girls should present a copy of their personalized cookie dough at the time the first payment is due. Note: cookie dough cannot be used for camp deposit(s). Cookie dough for camp should be emailed to [summercampregistrar@gshg.org](mailto:summercampregistrar@gshg.org) along with a completed Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia Cookie Dough Redemption form.

### GIRL SCOUT DESTINATIONS

Every girl deserves a chance to experience wanderlust! Girl Scouts offers many opportunities to see new places meet new people and learn about different cultures. Girl Scout Destinations are the ultimate adventure for individual girls ages 11 and older, with different trips hosted each year by Girl Scout councils and other organizations around the world. There's something amazing for everyone. To search for your own exciting adventure, visit the travel section of the Girl Scouts of the USA web page to apply.

Once a girl receives her Destinations acceptance letter, a copy of the letter, the completed GSHG Cookie Dough Redemption Form and her personalized emailed cookie dough should be submitted to the program manager in her local office. GSHG cut a check to the Destination host as a payment on behalf of the girl.

### DISTRICT AND SERVICE AREA SPONSORED EVENTS

Cookie dough can be used to attend district and service area sponsored events. Girls should present a copy of their personalized emailed card to the district or service area event director at the time of registration.

### GOLD OR SILVER AWARD PROJECT EXPENSES

Cookie dough can be used to offset expenses related to Gold or Silver Award expenses. Girls will need to contact their local Program Manager for details.

### GIRL SCOUTS OF THE USA LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP

Ambassador Girl Scouts who are graduating from high school can use their cookie dough toward their lifetime GSUSA membership. Girls present a lifetime membership form and a copy of their personalized cookie dough card, along with additional payment if needed.
