Dear Girl Scout family,

Your daughter is participating in the **I am a Philanthropist** program with her Girl Scout troop. This program will help her identify the good deeds that she does with her Girl Scout troop and why helping others is important. I encourage you to discuss **I am a Philanthropist** with your daughter.

The girls have set a reasonable financial goal for each of them to bring to the next troop meeting. Each girl's donation will be small, and when the troop leader adds them together, they will learn how working as a team makes small actions even more powerful.

Your daughter should discuss with you:

- The amount of her donation
- How she plans to earn her share
- The total amount of the troop's donation
- A request for your family to match the troop's total (Larger donations would help serve even more girls.)

The Girl Scout council spends \$329 per year on each local girl in Girl Scouting. Program fees and cookie sales provide 79% of the funds. **Philanthropy** provides the remaining \$69 per girl.

The entire Girl Scout community is asked to support annual giving and spread Girl Scouts' culture of philanthropy. It is possible that your employer matches charitable giving, which would give your gift extra power to positively affect girl programs. Please consider talking to your HR representative about a matching gift.
