

National Recognitions for Longevity of Service and Membership Volunteer Service Award Pin



The Volunteer Service Award Pin recognizes an adult member registered with the Girl Scouts of the U.S.A. for her years of active volunteer service at five-year intervals.

Criteria: The candidate:

- is an active adult member of Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia
- is not red-flagged by the Council (e.g., owes money)
- has completed 5, 10, (increments of 5) years of service as a registered adult Girl Scout
- completed the specified number of years of volunteer service by September 30 of the year prior to the nomination

Nomination: Self-nominated or submitted with Service Area list; nominees are under the honor system to report their total years.

Approval: Service Area Manager, Adult Recognition Chair, or Staff Member

Form of Recognition: 5, 10, and 15 year pins are presented at Service Area event; pins for higher years of service are presented at a Council level Awards event.



Membership Numeral Guard

The Membership Numeral Guard recognizes the total years of registered membership in any Girl Scout/Girl Guide organization at five-year intervals. Years as a girl member plus years as an adult member are combined for this recognition.

Criteria: The candidate:

- is an active adult member of in Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia
- is not red-flagged by the Council (e.g., owes money)
- has completed 5, 10, (increments of 5) years of membership as a registered Girl Scout
- completed the specified number of years of membership by September 30 of the year prior to the nomination

Nomination, Approval, and Form of Recognition: The same as for the Volunteer Service Award Pin.

****NOTE:** It is customary to wear just one of the applicable membership pins at a time, either the Volunteer Service Award or the Membership Numeral Guard, but not both. GSHG will purchase the Volunteer Service Award and Service Areas or individuals may purchase the Membership Numeral Guard.

NEW NAME! Daisy's Leadership Pin

Recognizes an adult volunteer who has served in a troop leadership position (Leader or Co-leader) in Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia for at least 3 years.
