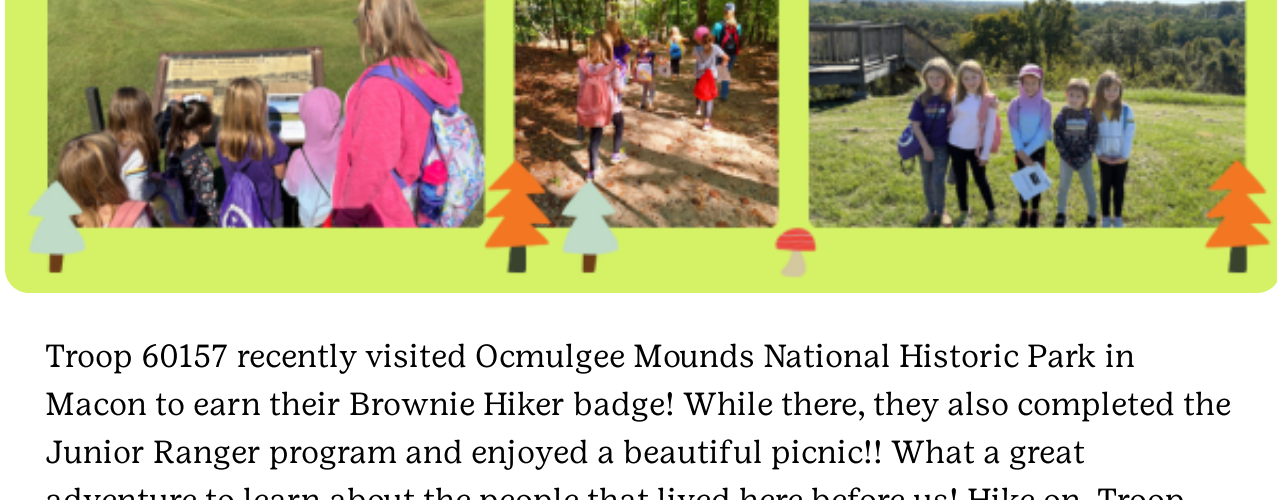

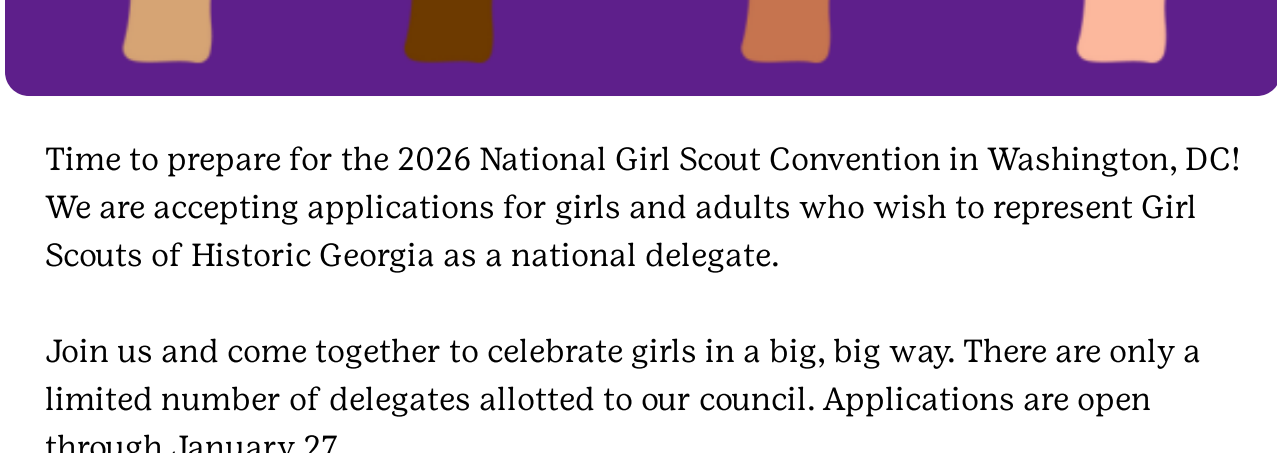

Please note, you must be willing to commit to the following:

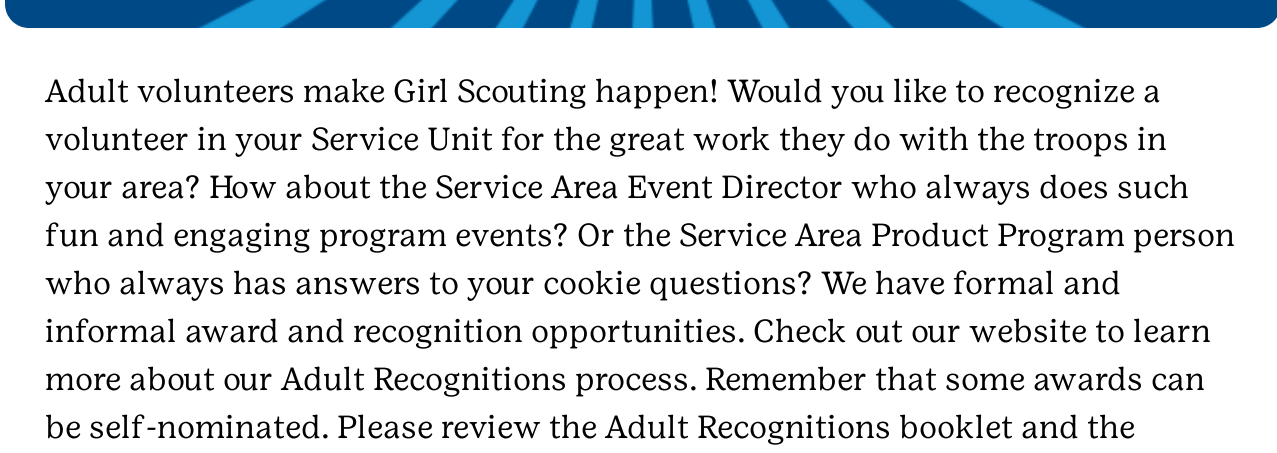
- Must reserve July 19-26, 2026 for travel to the National Council Session in Washington D.C.

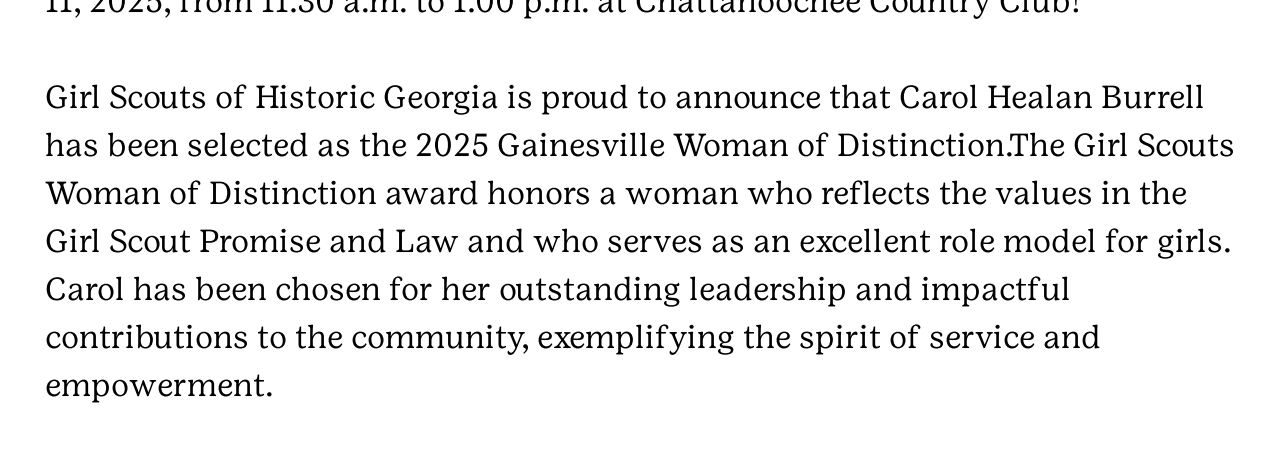
2. Adult Awards and Recognitions
