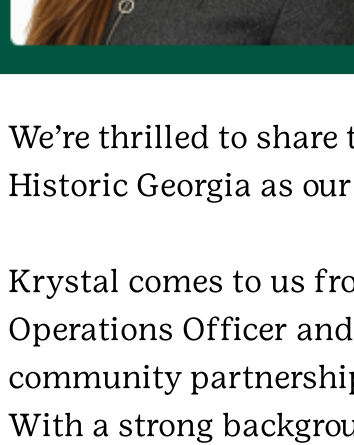

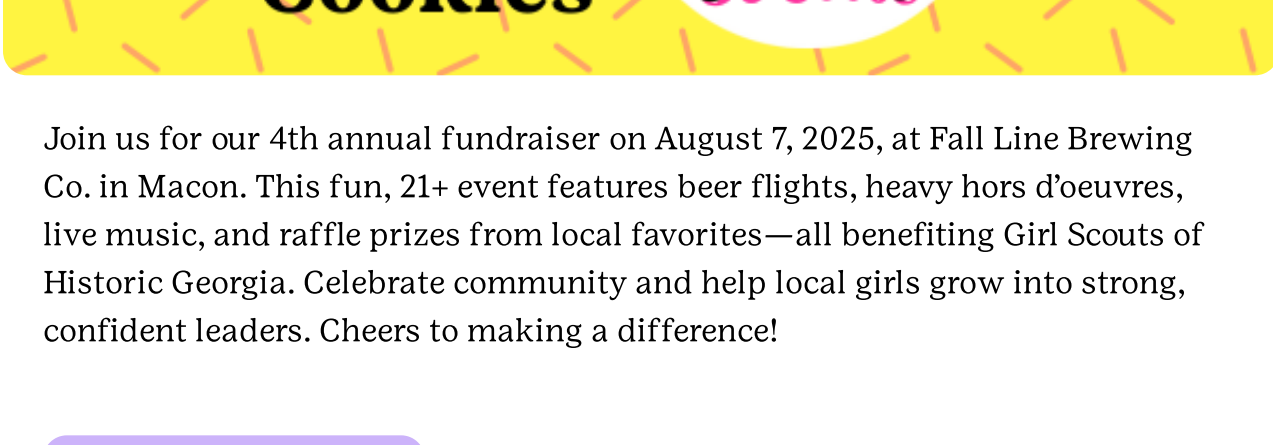
How to Join

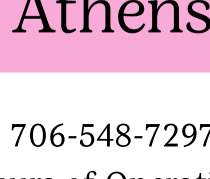
