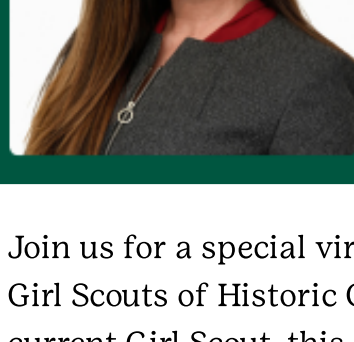

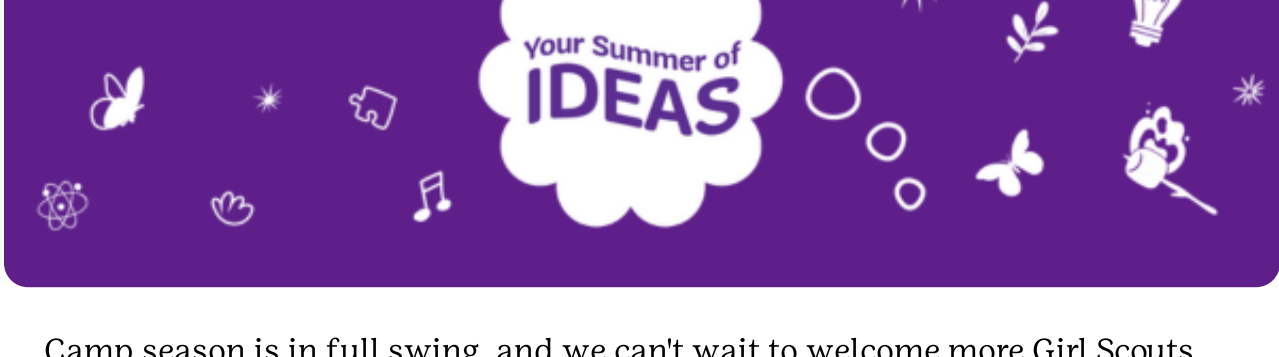

- Frequently asked questions and contact info

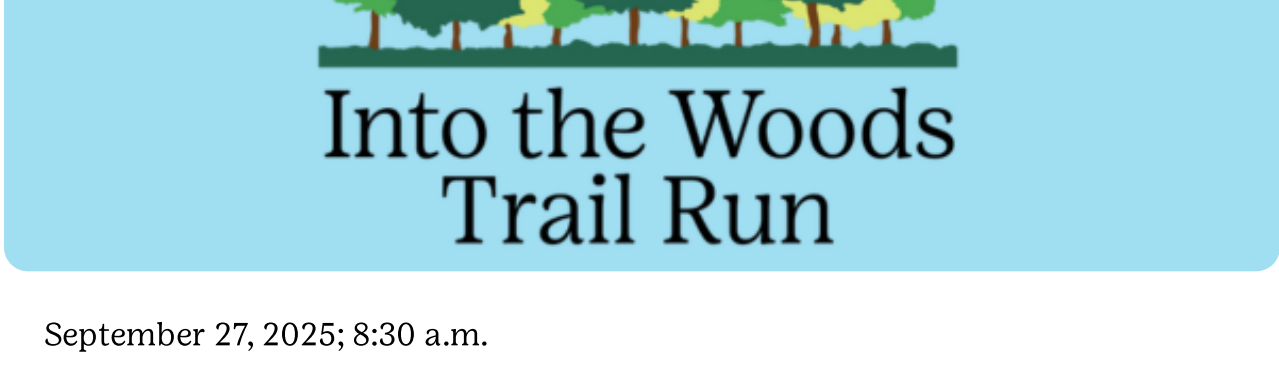

September 27, 2025; 8:30 a.m.

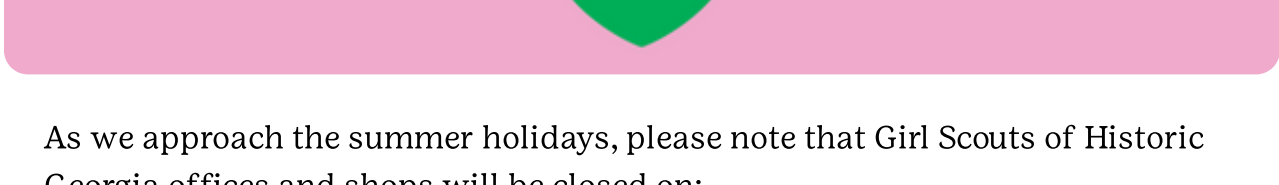
