As girls take orders for delectable edibles, personalized products, and terrific tumblers they build their self-esteem and develop a better understanding of the five essential skills:

- Goal setting
- Decision making
- Money management
- People skills
- Business ethics

Why Should My Girl Scout Participate?

The Fall Product Program is more than just providing products for your customers, Its the beginning platform for the Girl Scout Entrepreneurial Program through which girls learn essential skills that will stay with them throughout their lifetime.

This program allows a Girl Scout troop to earn funds while having fun at the start of the Girl Scout year and gives her family and friends a way to support Girl Scouting in their community. The girls take orders online through their digital storefronts or in person with their paper order card. The proceeds earned stay with her troop and help support troop activities, participation in events, buy badges and patches, and more.

Also, girls earn cool patches and rewards with personalized avatars they create themselves.

This year's mascot is the kangaroo, so let's hop to the next steps to make sure your Girl Scout is ready to join us in the **2026 GSHG Fall Product Program**.

November 2	2026 Fall Product Program ends! Digital storefronts close
November 23	Girl delivery of products to customer
Early December	Fall Product Program rewards delivery

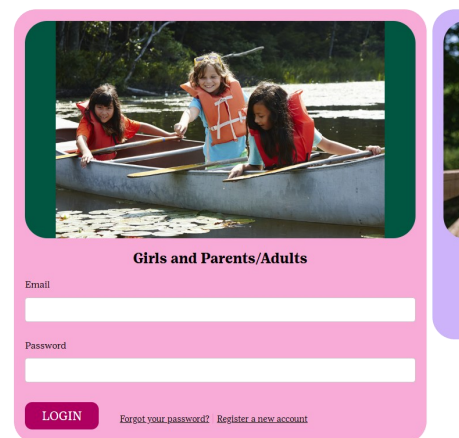
How to Participate

If your Girl Scout has participated in a previous Fall Product Program:

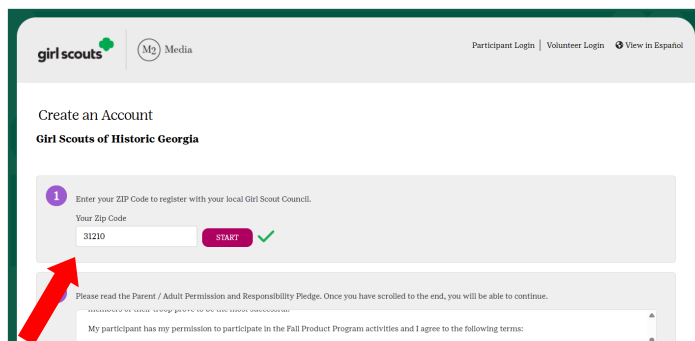
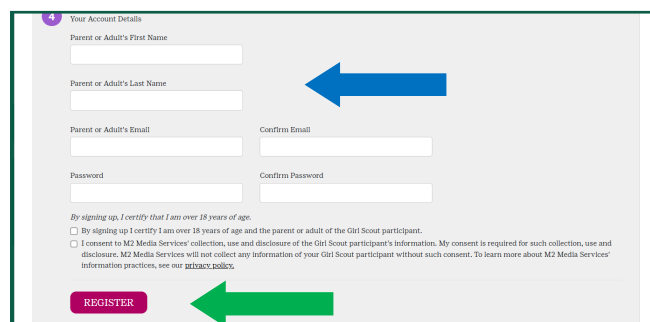
1. Click **“Login”** and enter your email and password

Creating a New Account

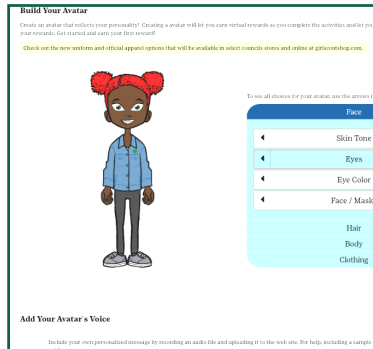
To create an Account:

- Enter **“Your Zip Code”** to verify access to Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia council
- Read and accept the Caregiver / Adult Permission and Responsibility Pledge
- Read and accept the Girl Scout Participant Pledge
- Enter **“Your Account Details”** and have your troop number for this step
- Click **“Register”**
- Remember to **search by girl's last name**
- If you are having issues, please contact your troop fall product program manager (TFPPM)

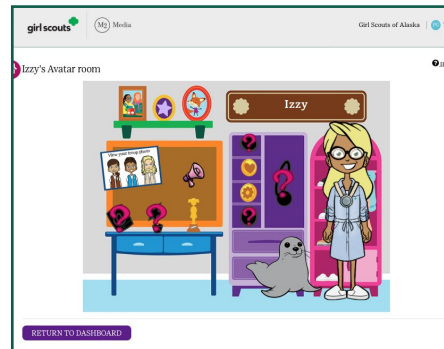



Explore Your Girl Scout's Online Site

How the Fall Product Program Works

The Fall Product Program offers an assortment of nuts and chocolates, magazines, personalized products, BarkBox treats for dogs, and Tervis tumblers. The table below shows how the order process can work for your Girl Scout. All materials will come from the troop fall product program manager (TFPPM).

In-Person/Order Card Nuts and Chocolates	Girl Scout collects orders and payments using order card Caregivers enter orders into M2 by 11:59 p.m. on 10/28	Orders are delivered by participating Girl Scouts the week of 11/23
Online Girl Delivered Nuts and Chocolates	Girl Scout creates an online storefront through M2 and shares online selling link with friends and family Customers order and pay online Orders are automatically credited to the Girl Scout Order taking ends 11/2	Orders are delivered by participating Girl Scout the week of 11/23
Online Direct Ship Nuts and Chocolates	Girl Scout creates an online storefront through M2 and shares online selling link with friends and family Customers pay online including cost of shipping	Orders are shipped directly to the customer
Online-only Mags and More	Orders are automatically credited to the Girl Scout Order taking ends 11/2

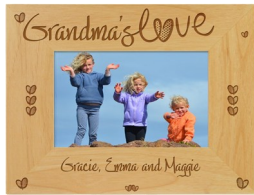

Tips to Keep Your Fall Product Program Hopping Along

- All online orders are sent immediately for processing once paid and submitted—no additional button to click
- If the girl has not submitted her payments for her paper orders to the troop fall product program manager by the deadline of 10/28 her orders **will not** be placed
- Girls automatically receive the rewards as they reach each level, no selection is required
- There is **no** cupboard with additional product for sale, and you cannot return product to the council office
- If the customer has a concern with their purchase a customer service number is available through the M2 site
- Caregivers and their Girl Scout should download her delivery list from the girl's dashboard on 11/2: **Sales Report > Online Nuts Girl Delivered**; this list can be used during the cookie program for potential customer orders
