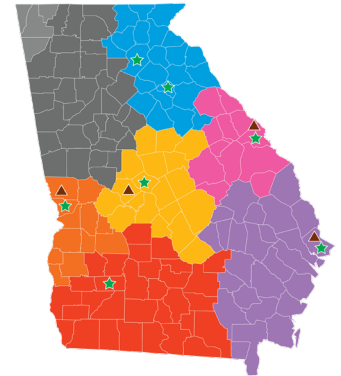

- More than 48,000 square miles



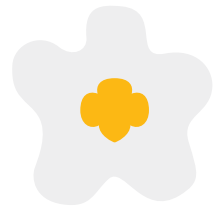
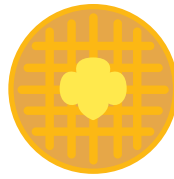
