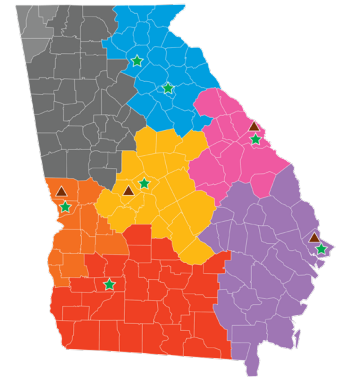
About Girl Scouts of Historic Georgia
