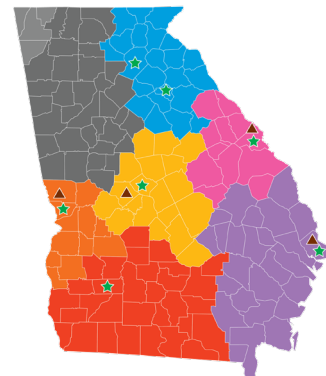
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Girl Scouts is the premiere leadership development organization for girls and has been for more than 100 years.

- More than 11,000 girls and 4,000 adults in 122 counties in Georgia, two counties in South Carolina, and one county in Alabama
- More than 48,000 square miles
