Early Bird Registration is Here!

Calling all explorers! We know that you have been having an amazing year of fun and adventure, but are you ready for a year of exploration? Renew your membership from April 1 to June 30 and begin your journey of discovering more of what Girl Scouts has to offer!



Council Early Bird Incentives

- All girls who re-register for 2025 during the campaign (April 1-June 30) will receive the one-of-a-kind 2025 GSHG Early Bird Patch designed by a GSHG girl!
- Troops who re-register 80% of their girls and 2 adults during the first 2 weeks (April 1-14) will receive \$50!
- Troops who re-register 80% of their girls and 2 adults in the following weeks (April 15-June 30) of the campaign will receive \$25!
- Service Areas will receive \$1 for every girl who early bird registers during the campaign (April 1-June 30).

Extended Year Membership

For new members only

The extended year membership campaign runs from April 1 - July 31, 2024. The cost of an extended year membership is \$40 for girls and \$35 for adults. New members who join during this time will have an active membership until September 30, 2025.

Troop Size

A troop must consist of at least 5 girls. Older girl troops must consist of at least 3 girls.

Cookie Season Totals

This year there were 1,701,987 packages of cookies sold across the council. That's a 10% increase from last year's cookie program (1,548,796 packages sold in 22-23). Way to go, Girl Scouts!

Retail Updates

Uniform Heat Press Service at the Savannah Shop

As of March 25, we are now offering heat press service for uniform insignia only in our Savannah Shop. At this time, we will not have onsite heat pressing services in our other locations.

The cost is a \$12.00 service fee per vest/sash/tunic for the American flag, council ID, troop crest, and troop numbers (shipping is additional). Orders must be placed 48 hours in advance for 1-9 vests and 5 business days in advance for 10 or more vests. Heat press items are ineligible for refunds or exchanges.
