## **Early Bird Registration**

Early Bird Registration runs from April 1-June 30. This year's theme is "Your Year of Adventure." Here's a little blurb you can use when sharing with your service units and troops: We know that you have been having an amazing year of fun and exploration, but are you ready for a year of adventure? Renew your membership from April 1 to June 30 and continue your journey of discovering more of what Girl Scouts has to offer!

# **Council Early Bird Incentives**

- All girls who re-register for 2025 during the campaign (April 1-June 30) will receive the one-of-a-kind GSHG Early Bird patch designed by a GSHG girl!
- Troops who re-register 80% of their girls and 2 adults during the first 2 weeks (April 1-15) will receive \$50!
- Troops who re-register 80% of their girls and 2 adults in the following weeks (April 16-June 30) of the campaign will receive \$25!
- Service Areas will receive \$1 for every girl who early bird registers during the campaign (April 1-June 30).
- Don't forget to check out the early bird incentives for your region!





#### Reminder:

For the membership year 2025-2026, which begins on October 1, girl memberships will be \$45, plus a \$5 council fee, and adult memberships will be \$30.

# **Extended Year Membership for New Members**

Know someone ready to start their Girl Scout journey? Invite them to join with an Extended Year Membership and unlock up to 5 extra months of adventure! Starting April 1, 2025, their membership will run all the way through September 30, 2026—giving them even more time to make friends, explore new skills, and create unforgettable memories.

# gsLearn Updates

GSHG is transitioning to a new mandated reporter training created by GSUSA and our liability insurance provider, Palmer and Cay. The course, 325 GSHG: Mandated Reporter Training and Acknowledgement for Volunteers, will be live in gsLearn in May. It will include GSUSA's Girl Scouts Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention course, along with an e-signature form to sign that volunteers acknowledge that they are mandated reporters in the state of Georgia as volunteers for Girl Scouts. We will transition away from the state training over the summer.
