It's time for your favorite part of the cookie program - booth sales! Initial Order deliveries are scheduled between February 1 – 7. Your Service Unit Product Program Manager will reach out with the confirmed delivery date, time and location! Head over the Reports tab in eBudde and click Pickup Sheets so you know what you are picking up.

February 9 marks the beginning of the booth sale portion of the cookie program. Troop Cookie Managers, grab your tablecloths, and girls, practice your sales pitch. Have a booth sale location in mind? Complete the Cookie Booth Request Letter or share our online form so your troop can set up a booth sale at a local business.

Your Cookie Cupboards will open for reorders starting February 5 at 10 am. Your earliest pick up day is February 8. If you would like to pick up at one of the Apple Moving warehouses or are requesting a delivery, you may place that order starting February 12. Cookies on the Go Charm

Earn your Cookies on the Go Charm by offering your Girl Scout cookies to neighbors between February 5-11. Make sure to submit this form to earn your charm!

Initial ACH Draft

February 20 marks our Initial ACH Draft. Ensure that all cash payments are in your Troop Bank Account. Use the formula below to determine that amount needed for the withdrawal.

1st ACH Draft = (total IO in pkgs + Others+Extras-Charity) * \$5 / 2 - DOC Bank Payments made up until 2/15

What if I don't have that amount for the first ACH draft in my Troop Bank Account? Contact your Regional Product Program Manager before February 16! You will be asked to complete the ACH Delinquent Request form and communicate the amount we are able to pull from your account. Note that once this form is submitted, you will not be permitted to order more cookies from your local cupboard or warehouse until your Initial ACH Draft is paid in full.

Other upcoming dates and deadlines:

- February 1-7: Initial Order Cookie Drops
- February 5: Troops can start reordering to the Cookie Cupboards
- February 8: Troops can begin picking up from the Cookie Cupboards
- February 12: Troops can begin picking up from the warehouses and requesting deliveries
- February 16-18: National Girl Scout Cookie Weekend
- February 16: Troops must request a decrease in the amount of Initial ACH withdrawal
- February 20: Initial ACH Draft

Girl Scouts is a vibrant, living, and constantly evolving community - and so is our visual identity. Our brand is not just a logo - it is a complete design system composed of a number of elements that work together to create a distinctive look and feel for all our communications.

Branding Pro Tip: Use only GSUSA-approved fonts in your designs!

Want to create flyers to help grow your troop? Looking to invite girls to a Service Unit event? Make sure you are only using GSUSA-approved fonts in your designs.

In order to advance our brand through a unified voice, GSUSA uses a custom typeface that is uniquely its own—appropriately named "Girl Scout." This typeface was created exclusively for Girl Scouts and is a contemporary reimagining of an old-style serif font reminiscent of typography from the time of our founding in 1912.

Girl Scout font is Intellectual Property of GSUSA, so volunteers, Girl Scouts, and parents should use "Palatino Linotype" for flyers, posters, social media graphics, etc.
