Troops receive a Welcome Box followed by up to 7 monthly boxes, depending on their start date. Shipments begin in August and each box ships for a limited time. The boxes include:

Council Early Bird Incentives

Summer is the perfect time to update your GSUSA adult training and Region 2 - Augusta is starting something new.



July 18-19: Leader Glamporee - Macon

Join us for a weekend of learning, laughter, and connection! Whether you're a brand-new leader, a returning volunteer, or a longtime supporter, this weekend is designed just for you. Learn new skills, gain fresh ideas, and enjoy the company of passionate Girl Scout adults-all in the beautiful setting of Camp Martha Johnston.

July 18-19: ARC Lifeguard Training - Macon

When girls swim or are in the water for some Girl Scout activities, one adult in attendance must be currently lifeguard certified and act as the lifeguard for the activity. This course will run during the same time as Leader Glamporee. Participants that also register for Glamporee can spend the night at camp and have breakfast and lunch provided on Saturday.





August 8-9: Basic Backpacking - Augusta

Join us to learn the skills to successfully plan and carry out an overnight or weeklong backpacking trek. You will learn what you need to teach your older girls so they will be ready to embark on a backpacking trip as a troop or group. At the end of the course, you will plan an overnight backpacking trip for Fall 2025 or Spring 2026 and choose a place to go on your own adventure, so you will gain the experience of an overnighter in the wilderness using the skills learned during this course. Don't worry, your instructor will go on this trip with you and help you plan a successful trip.

gsLearn Updates

GSHG is transitioning to a new mandated reporter training created by GSUSA and our liability insurance provider, Palmer and Cay. The course, 325 GSHG: Mandated Reporter Training and Acknowledgement for Volunteers, went live in late May. It includes the course from GSUSA, GSUSA Girl Scouts Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Course, along with an e-signature form to sign that volunteers acknowledge that they are mandated reporters in the state of Georgia as volunteers for Girl Scouts. We will transition away from the state training over this summer. Updates will be made to our website accordingly.

Product Program

Start getting Product Program ready now!

- Be a registered Girl Scout volunteer, with approved background check, for the current Girl Scout Membership year. You must have the troop cookie program manager role assigned to you in myGS to have access to your troop eBudde dashboard.
- In order to be Product Program-ready, you must have two (non-related and background checked) volunteers assigned to the troop leadership role in myGS.
- For troops with fewer than 5 registered girls in grades K-5 and/or fewer than 3 registered girls in grades 6-12, you may continue to participate in upcoming Product Programs IF you are open in the Troop Catalog. To verify, call Customer Care at 1-888-689-1912.

New! \$15.00 of Cookie Program Credits can be applied towards your total \$50.00 GSHG membership cost. These credits cannot be applied towards an adult Girl Scout membership. Complete the <u>Cookie Program Credit Request Form</u> for processing.



New! Council Cookie Program Credits can be used towards all online shops, including GSUSA shop and GSHG shop. Shipping is an additional cost for which credits do not apply. Orders can be placed for local council shop pick-up for no additional fee.

Council Cookie Program Credits can also go towards:

- Council events
- Service Unit sponsored events
- GSHG resident, day, or travel camp
- Girl Scout Destinations
- Silver/Gold Award project expenses
- GSHG membership (up to \$15)
- GSUSA Lifetime Membership (for Ambassadors only)

All Cookie Program Credits expire on December 15, 2025.
