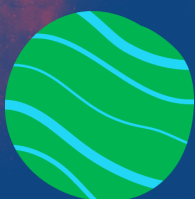

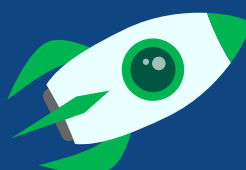

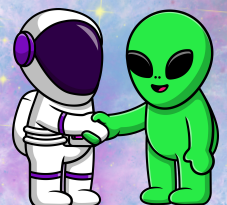

What to bring to LEAP?

Swaps – Bring about 60

Auction items – baskets, jewelry, GS like items etc

Money for Auction – auction tickets at .25 each

Labels with your name for your auction tickets (saves you time)

Scissors

Cup on a string/reusable water bottle

Reusable coffee cup

Bedding – Pillow, extra blankets, bedroll or sleeping bag

Rain jacket, sweater, coat, hat (Check weather)

Toiletries

Closed toe shoes

Shower shoes or flip flops

Towel, washcloth

Soap, shampoo

Toothbrush/paste

Flashlight/batteries

Clothes for 2 nights and 3 days

Where are the accommodations at Camp Low?

Cabins Unit names are: Tidewater & White Caps

Platform Tents Unit names are: Driftwood and Salt Meadows
(Driftwood and Salt Meadows Units also have 1 cabin each that sleeps 8).

Cabins - Cabins have 4 or 8 beds. Some cabins have electrical outlets, first priority on cabins are given to those with medical needs.

Cabins **do not** have heat or air conditioning; however, they do have a ceiling fan. Please come prepared for the weather (i.e. extra blankets, etc.)

Platform tents – Platform tents have 4 beds. Tents have **no electricity**.

Bathhouses – Bathhouses are separate from cabins and are located just a few steps from cabins. They have electricity and outlets. A unit house is located in every unit.

Lodge – The Lodge has central air and heat. Some activities and meals occur here. The Lodge has one bathroom.

Weather – South Georgia weather is hard to predict. Please watch the weather forecast for Savannah, Georgia, in the days prior to LEAP.

Meals- We will do our best to meet most dietary restrictions. However, if you have strict dietary needs, you may want to bring food to supplement your meals.

REMEMBER:

- Classes are filled on a **first come first serve basis**. So the earlier you get your registration in, the more likely you will get the classes you want.
- If you order a T-shirt, make sure that you indicate the size and number of shirts you want.
- When registering make sure under restrictions and limitations you list current data. (I.E. You hurt your leg, what does that mean? Cannot walk long distances? Cannot climb stairs? etc.), (You have a heart condition, what does that mean? Does it mean you cannot walk long distances, cannot be exposed to extremes in weather?) Telling us the problem does not help us to serve you if you do not list the limitations like above.
